COST OF ATTENDANCE

- Cost of Attendance (COA) falls into two categories:
 - “Dependent” students living at home with parents
 - “All Others”
 - Dependent students living in an apartment, or elsewhere
 - Independent students

These costs include tuition and fees, textbook and kit items, the cost of obtaining a professional license, personal expenses, transportation costs to attend school and work as well as the average of food and housing allowance of surveyed residents.

Listed below is the COA Budget for each program (including all FT/HT) that has qualified for Title IV, HEA funding. The COA elements are derived from surveying residents to find the average or median amount assessed, whichever is greater, rather than actual charges.
